

Shepherd's Cross Intern & Resident Suggested Packing List

- T-shirts
- Blue jeans
- Capris
- Sweaters/ Hoodies
- Work gloves
- Work boots
- Closed-toed shoes
- Wool socks/ Boot socks
- Rain boots
- Rain coat
- Country-style attire – which can include the following:
 - Jeans
 - Knee length capris – jean style
 - (For the ladies) Blue jean skirt (at least knee length)
 - Denim vest
 - Aprons
 - Plaid button-up shirts
 - T shirts
- Hat (to provide ample shade – e.g. ball cap, cowboy hat, sun hat etc. Be sure that it fits secure to withstand the Oklahoma wind.)
- Belt
- Stocking cap (fall & spring semesters)
- Mittens or warm lined gloves (fall & spring semesters)
- Scarf (worn well-secured so as not to get caught in anything) (fall & spring semesters)
- Winter coat (fall & spring semesters)
- Long johns and winter overalls (fall & spring semesters)
- Come prepared for some clothing to be stained or otherwise damaged. Bring extras. Set aside nicer articles of clothing for open days and meeting the public. *Attire must cover the belly, thighs, shoulders, bust, back, and tattoos (if any)*. To keep with the farm dress code, we ask that our interns not color their hair any unnatural colors.
- Bible, personal devotional materials, journal
- Camera
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Toiletries and other personal items
- Notepad, pencil or pen
- Pocket knife
- Water bottle
- Backpack (to carry a change of clothes & items needed for the work day)
