

Job Title: Wool Mill Attendant & Tour Guide

Job Description: Process wool in our full service, all natural wool mill & provide educational tours related to the wool mill, and as it relates to the Bible

Job Duties (Detailed): Wool Processing, including but not limited to: washing, picking, carding, tumbling, felting, spinning, knitting, crocheting and weaving. Additionally wool workers provide the wool mill tour both downstairs in the wool processing area, and upstairs in the museum. Tours are both factually based and Biblically related, referring to wool and fiber processing in the Bible. This position also will include keeping the wool processing area and the museum areas clean (dusting, vacuuming, mopping, trash out etc.) This person will also be responsible for assisting in fiber arts instructional classes on a regular basis.

We do extensive training for the individual hired for this position, including the wool mill work, wool tour information, and Biblical wool related tour information.

Job Requirements (Detailed): Seeking an individual that has some previous experience in fiber arts. Individual must be able to easily climb stairs; our tours are upstairs and downstairs. Individual must be able to work with hot water, in a setting similar to the heat and water factor of a restaurant kitchen. Applicants must be able to kneel down to skirt the wool fleeces. Applicants must be able to lift wool bags, fleeces, yarn, storage bins and more.
