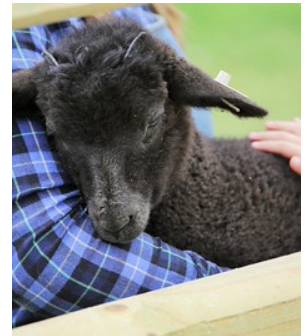

- If you are running late for your tour, please contact us in advance. We are making preparations for you and your group. Thank you for your consideration.
- If there is inclement weather, we are able to continue with the tour inside the tour barn facility and educational farm silo. This is a large educational facility and we can accommodate your group. Unless there is severe weather at the farm, the morning of the day of the tour, the tour will not be cancelled; we will proceed. Please call the morning of the tour if there are any questions.
- This is an outdoor field trip. Please dress accordingly. This is an authentic working farm.
- We will walk through a barn and a barnyard and/or a garden. We will get barn yard materials and dirt on our shoes. Please wear close toed shoes or boots. Boots are highly recommended.
- *Recommendation: some tour groups bring plastic sacs (grocery store sacs) to tie or rubber band around their shoes. These are inexpensive, throw away type boots. They are effective. You may consider doing this. It will save dirt going into the vehicle.*
- This is a guided, hands on, educational field trip. Please be prepared to listen quietly.
- Shepherd's Shop will be open. The Gift Shop features the farm's own produce, meats and wool products as well as locally hand made items and a special mission section. Items with a Heart of the Shepherd label (our non-profit) return 100% of the proceeds to missions.
- There is a small concession area.
- There is a modern, indoor bathroom facility and baby changing tables.
- We accept cash, all major credit cards and SNAP EBT benefits.
- Directions available on the website. The farm is approximately one hour from Tulsa.
- If you have scheduled a picnic, table reservations are for 45 minutes.
- Please respect the animals. No running, no horse play, and no loud voices in the barn or pasture.
- Please stay with the tour group at all times.
- Parents and/or teachers are responsible for the oversight of the children/individuals in their group.
- We encourage parental and supervisor participation.
- If your tour is on a donation basis, then we thank you in advance for your donation. If this is a tour with an activity such as a hayride or planting activity, all participants are asked to pay for the activity. Thank you. (one free supervisor for 10 paid students).
